

THE NARROWS TO ERICA WEIR AND O'SHEA'S MILL

WALK 11

Distance	13 km
Duration	5 hours
Grading	Medium-Hard



Walk Description

This walk is through mixed forest and involves a small off track section and one river crossing.

We travel up the Thomson Valley Road to the Narrows and leave the cars to walk up a spur to the weir. As the name suggests the weir serves the nearby township of Erica. This part of the walk takes about an hour. From here we head off track through thick bush with a lot of decaying timber and tree ferns. This short section of 300 meters takes approximately 50 minutes. On the way you will be able to stop and wonder at a massive gum tree. We continue off track until reaching the Australian Alps Waling Track. Turning left onto the Australian Alps Walking Track we head downhill through a lovely forest to the site of O'Shea's Mill. This will be our lunch spot. The section from arriving on the Australian Alps Walking Track to O'Shea's Mill takes 1.5 hours.

After lunch continue on the Australian Alps Walking Track to the Thomson Valley Road and then walk on the track which runs parallel with the road and back to the cars. It is suggested that walkers bring gaiters and have clean dry socks and a towel at the cars.

Getting to the Start

Start and finish at The Narrows, this involves approximately 6 km car travel from Rawson.
