

RAWSON TO POVERTY POINT CIRCUIT

WALK 19

Distance	14 km
Duration	5 hours
Grading	Medium



Walk Description

This walk visits the historic Poverty Point Bridge built in June 1900. At this point the walk joins the Australian Alps Walking Track. You will enjoy varied mountain and river valley scenery. Interpretive signs along the track explain some of the history of the 'golden' days.

From Rawson head East along Old Depot Road down to the Thomson River. Follow the riverside track upstream to Poverty Point Bridge. Cross the bridge and follow the Australian Alps Walking Track till it intersects Mormon Town Track. Follow Mormon Town Track downhill and cross the Thomson River again on the road bridge. Visit Thomson Station.

After visiting Thomson Station head north and then west up Old Depot Road back to Rawson.

Getting to the Start

This walk commences and finishes at Rawson Village.
