

KNOTT'S SIDING, COOPERS CREEK CIRCUIT

WALK 17

Distance	15 km
Duration	5 hours
Grading	Medium



Walk description

This circuit walk takes in the old Moe-Walhalla Rail line, the current township of Erica and surrounding farmland and passes through the old copper mining town of Coopers Creek. Wildflowers may be seen at any time of year. The area has a rich gold and copper mining history. Much of the area was logged heavily during the gold mining era to provide fuel for crushing machinery and supports for tunnels. The rich red soil near Erica is used extensively for potato growing.

Getting to the start

The walk starts at Knott's Siding, approximately 2 km south of Rawson on the Tyers-Walhalla Road at the junction of the turnoff to Walhalla.
