Walk Description

If you have an interest in gold mining or the history of Walhalla this walk is a must. It starts outside the cemetery gates, at the bottom end of the main street and takes in many of the historical sites and land marks around the town. This includes the cemetery, many of the mine sites and much more. John Aldersea who is leading this walk has lived in Walhalla and has extensive knowledge of the Walhalla and the surrounding area.

John and his partner Barbara Hood wrote a wonderful history of the town entitled “Walhalla the Valley of Gold: A Story of Its People, Places and Its Gold Mines”.

John and Barbara also filmed and produced a two part DVD entitled “Discovering Walhalla's history”.
