

WALK TITLE:	WOLLANGARRA VISIT
WALK NO:	1
DISTANCE/TYPE:	4km / return walk
DURATION:	3 - 4 hours, depending on how long is spent on the guided tour of the Outdoor Education Centre.
GRADING:	Very Easy
ASCENT/DESCENT:	50/50 metres
PATH:	4WD vehicle track and Flying Fox across river



Walkers will learn how this independent, nont-for-profit organisation promotes environmental sustainability by supporting young (possibly disadvantaged) people to live the outdoor experience who may not otherwise have an opportunity to engage with the environment.

WALK DESCRIPTION: This walk is on private property and can only be undertaken with the permission of the Wollangarra Outdoor Education Centre. Start the walk by climbing over the stile next to the locked gate. Walk for 2 kms along a sandy river flat through private land staying on the vehicle track until the track ends at the bank of the Macalister River.

Now for the challenge of the walk. The only access to Wollangarra Outdoor Education Centre is via a flying fox. Staff will meet walkers to assist and supervise the group to cross the river. The flying fox has seats and safety bars.

On the other side, a short walk leads to the Homestead with its rustic buildings, vegetable gardens, water tanks and environmentally sustainable infrastructure off the grid. Staff will take walkers on a guided tour of the Centre.

After the tour and lunch walk back to the river, cross back on the flying fox and return to vehicles.

GETTING TO THE START: From Licola drive south towards Heyfield for 18.5 km to park near the locked gate on your right. Look out for the Wollangarra letter box – a forty-four-gallon drum on its side next to the gate.

Distance from the Licola Wilderness Village to the start of the walk is 18.5km.
